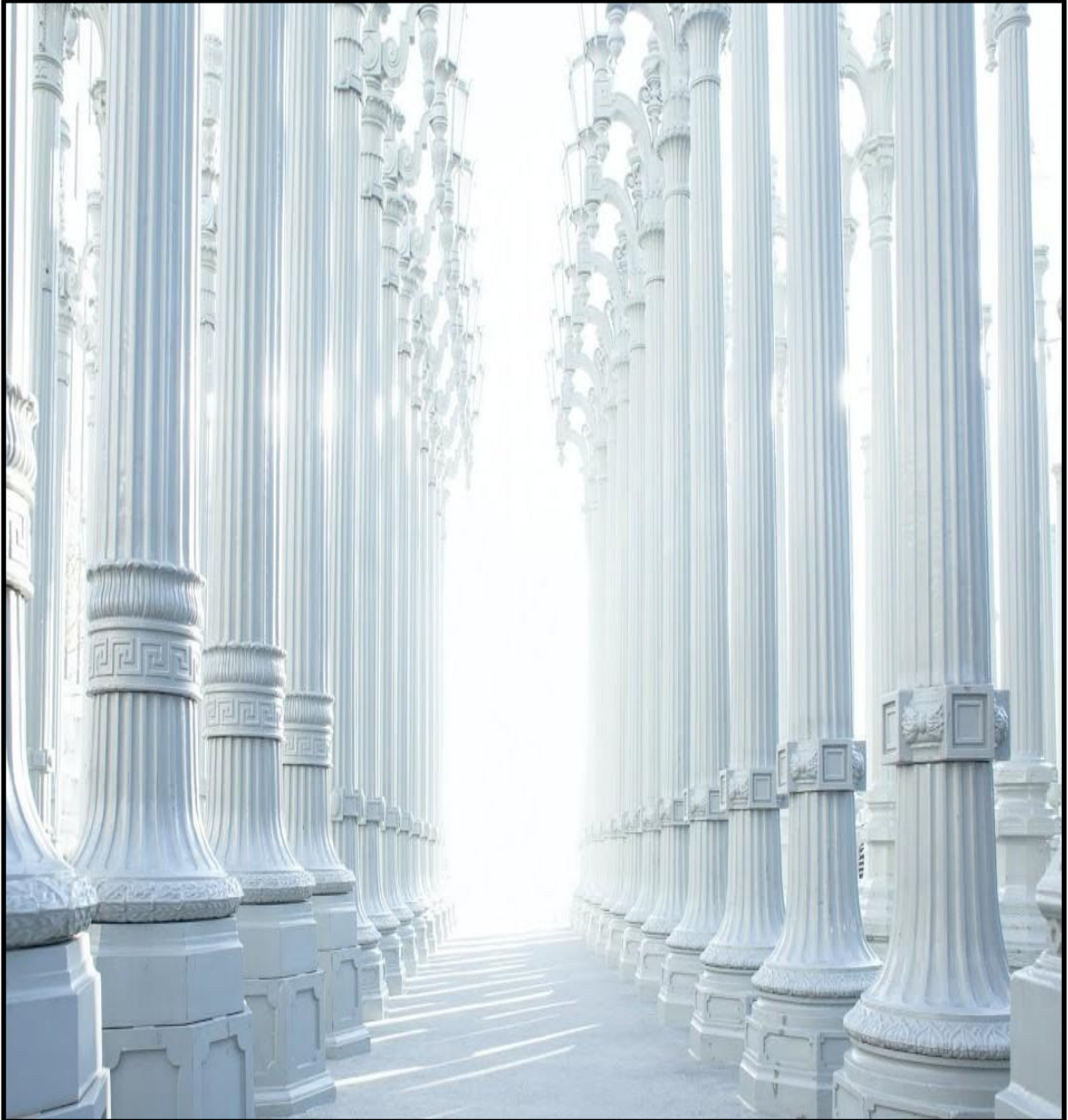

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The Timeline of Haggai's Four Prophecies

1 st prophecy	Haggai 1:1	To Zerubbabel and Joshua. (First day of the sixth month) 29 August 520 BC
	Haggai 1:15	The work of rebuilding began. (Twenty-fourth day of the sixth month) 21 September 520 BC
2 nd prophecy	Haggai 2:1	To Zerubbabel, Joshua and the remnant. (Twenty-first day of the seventh month) 17 October 520 BC
3 rd prophecy	Haggai 2:10	To the priests. (Twenty-fourth day of the ninth month) 18 December 520 BC
4 th prophecy	Haggai 2:20	To Zerubbabel. (Twenty-fourth day of the ninth month) 18 December 520 BC

Timeline of Major Events After the Fall of Babylon

539 BC — Cyrus the Great conquers Babylon
538 BC — Return under Zerubbabel and Jeshua (Joshua)
536 BC — Temple rebuilding came to a halt after two years (Ezra 4:24)
530 BC — Cambyses
522 BC — Darius I (Darius Hystaspes)
520 BC — Haggai prophesies (Haggai 1:1)
520 BC — Zechariah prophesies (Zechariah 1:1, Zechariah 7:1)
520 BC — Temple rebuilding recommences
516 BC — Temple completed
486 BC — Xerxes (Esther period)
465 BC — Artaxerxes I (Artaxerxes Longimanus)
458 BC — Ezra arrives
445 BC — Nehemiah arrives and stays for 12 years (Nehemiah 8:9)
432 BC — Nehemiah returns to Susa for 8 years (Nehemiah 13:6)
432-425 BC — Malachi prophesies somewhere during this period
425 BC — Nehemiah returns after 8 years (Nehemiah 13:29)

Note: Ezra and Nehemiah fit much later than the prophetic ministries of Haggai and Zechariah, **62** and **75 years** respectively.
